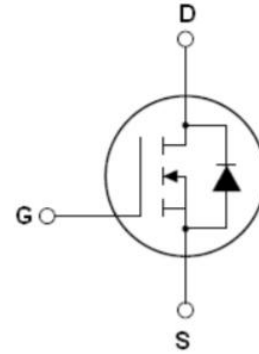

Figure1. Safe operating area

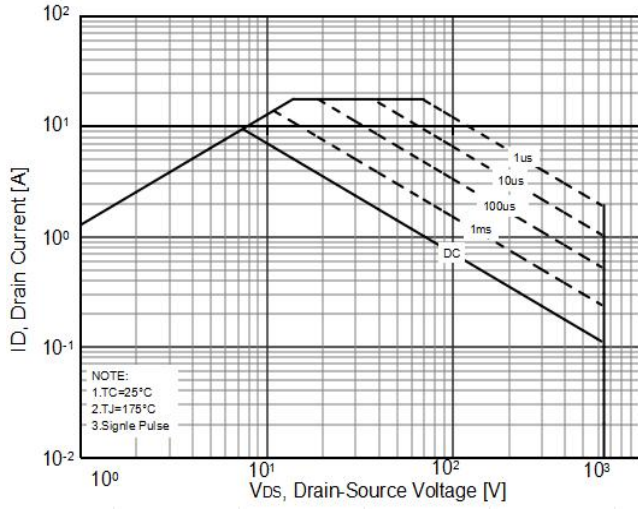


Figure2. Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage

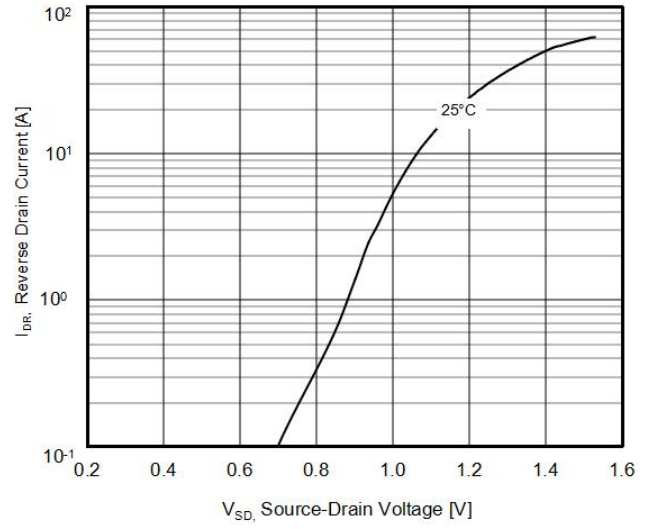


Figure3. Output characteristics

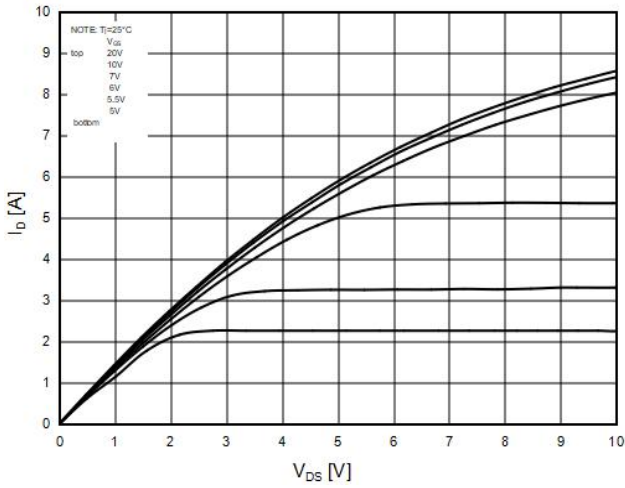


Figure4. Transfer characteristics

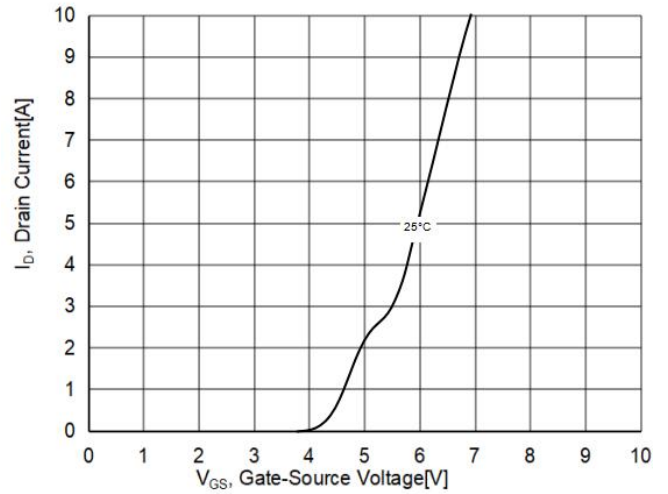


Figure5. Static drain-source on resistance

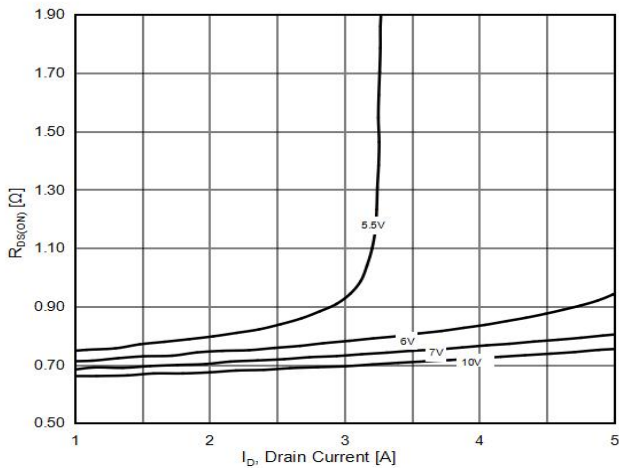


Figure6. RDS(ON) vs Junction Temperature

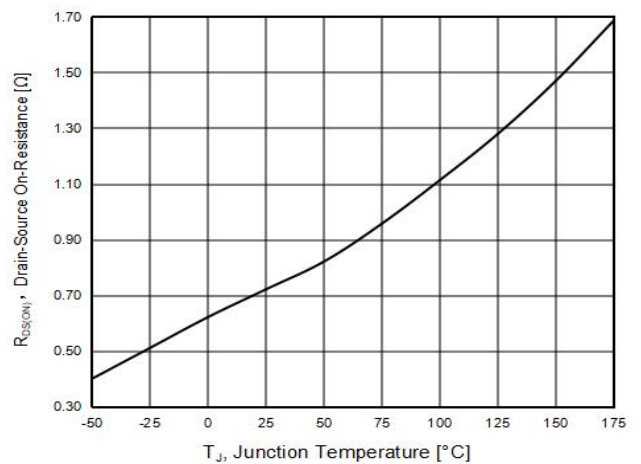


Figure7. BV_{DSS} vs Junction Temperature

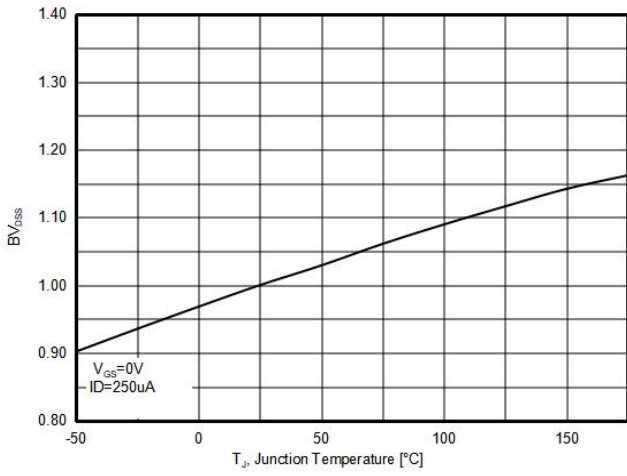


Figure8. Maximum I_D vs Junction Temperature

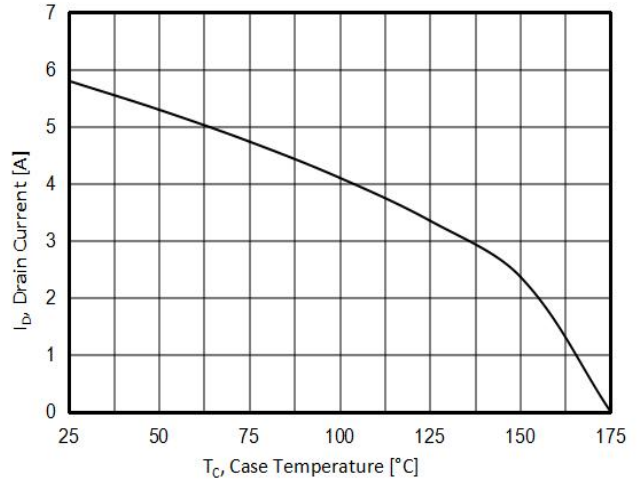


Figure9. Gate charge waveforms

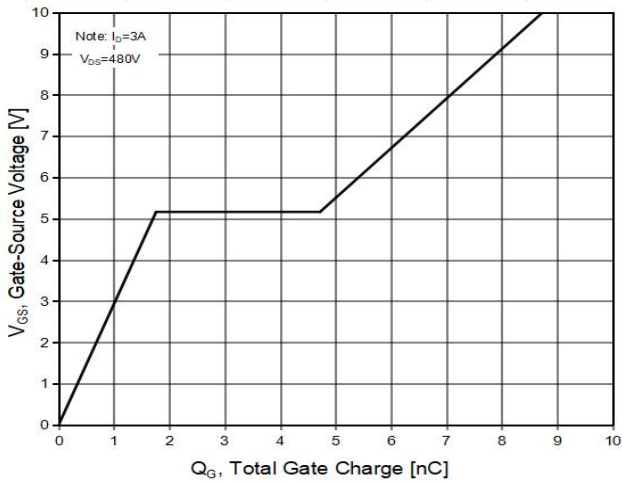
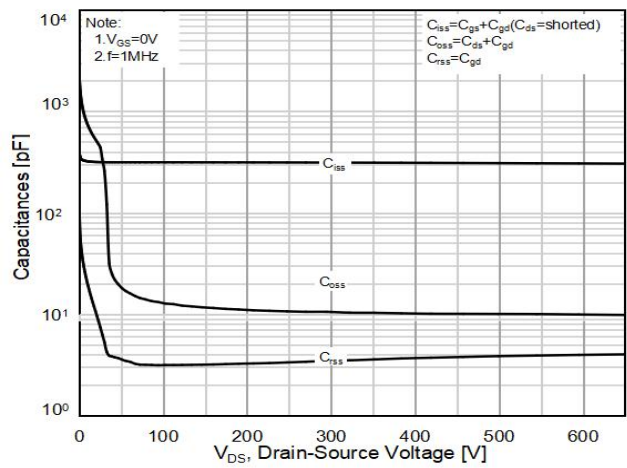


Figure10. Capacitance

1) Gate charge test circuit & Waveform



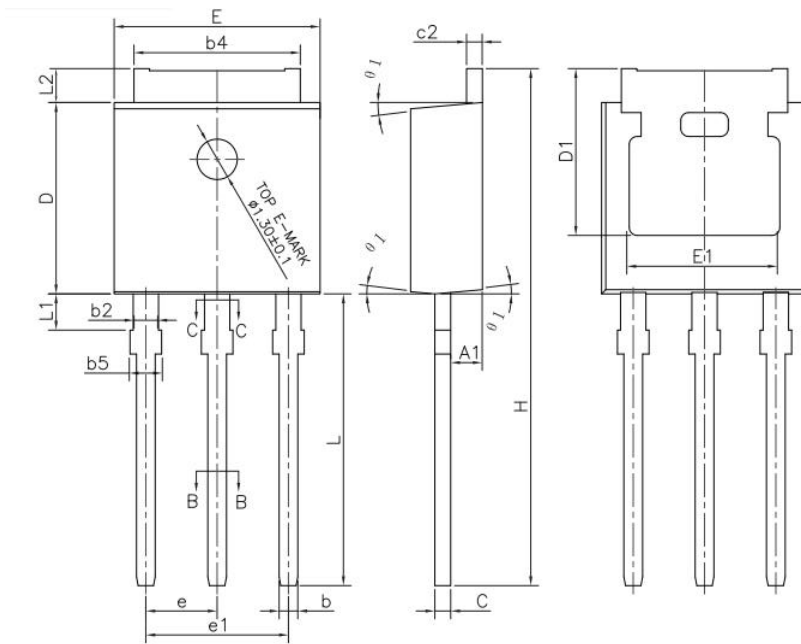
2) Switch Time Test Circuit:
